Birdathon: Pledges Still Welcome!

Birdathon results are in! The Oldtimers team reported 92 species, the Ghost Busters 40. The North East Corner had 85 species, the Big Sit 39, and Krazy Kayakers saw 71. This year traditional rivals, the Urbana Park District and the Champaign County Forest Preserve District, combined forces instead of competing; their total was 132 species!

Spring Bird Count Results

The 2016 Spring Bird Count was held in Champaign County on Saturday May 7. Each team of 1-4 birders was assigned to cover a specific area in the County. Almost all results are in, and so far a total of 164 species were seen on this rather nasty day. Highlights included a Red-breasted Merganser, 2 Loons, a Sandhill Crane, 26 species of warblers, and 2 Long-billed Dowitchers.

Aside from the Spring Bird Count, other highlights include a variety of shorebirds at the Curtis Road mudflat including Black-necked Stilts. Also there was a Black Tern. Elsewhere were a Marbled Godwit and abundant Golden Plovers as well as a Black-bellied Plover. A Trumpeter Swan showed up before and after the Bird Count day. A hybrid Lawrence's Warbler (between a Blue-winged and a Golden Winged) was in Crystal Lake park and later a Connecticut Warbler. An exciting time of year!
